### Course Overview:

This course was authored and edited by CMI and CHI certified interpreters, and was designed for U.S. interpreters who wish to expand their medical terminology and advance their medical interpreting skills. It is also an ideal preparatory course for certification with the National Board of Certification for Medical Interpreters (NBCMI) and the Certification Commission for Healthcare Interpreters (CCHI). You will practice sight, consecutive and simultaneous interpretation in the context of different medical encounters; review various body systems and hospital departments; and acquire as well as reinforce relevant vocabulary.

### Takeaway:

At the end of the training program, you will be thoroughly acquainted with protocols and procedures frequently used in various medical specialties. You will be better prepared to take on challenging medical interpretation assignments or NBCMI/CCHI certification exams with expanded medical vocabulary. Your UMIT certificate can be used as proof of specialized medical terminology training.
