Course Overview:

This course has been designed for interpreters who wish to expand their medical terminology and further advance their medical interpreting skills. You will practice sight, consecutive and simultaneous interpretation in the context of different medical encounters; review medical specialties including various body systems and hospital departments; as well as acquire and reinforce relevant vocabulary. There is also a wealth of reference materials and case studies to assist with your training.

Takeaway:

At the end of the training program, you will be thoroughly acquainted with protocols and procedures frequently used in various medical specialties. You will be better prepared to take on challenging medical interpretation assignments with expanded medical vocabulary. Your AMIT certificate can be used as proof of specialized medical terminology training, and entitles you to 10 Professional Development Units (PDUs) with OCCI.
